Ethics Contract

1. If any Student Government student posts inappropriate pictures on social media (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, TikTok, etc.) that shows the student in possession of ANY illegal substance or partaking in any illegal activities, the sponsor has the right to remove the student from SGA class the following semester. This includes any subtitles that may insinuate that the student is partaking in any illegal activity.
2. If any Student Government student posts pictures on a website (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, TikTok etc.) that shows the student in clothing considered immodest (emphasizing or revealing any body parts) and/or posts pictures demonstrating passionate displays of affection, the sponsor has the right to remove the student from SGA class the following semester.
3. An external suspension of one to three days will result in a sit-down conference with the student and the sponsor. Possible removal from the SGA class may occur the following semester. An external suspension of five days or more will result in the student's removal from the Student Government class the following semester.
4. Any student caught cheating, accompanied by a teacher referral, will result in a one-on-one conference with the sponsor. Possible removal from the SGA class may occur the following semester.
5. A student with excessive detentions (5 or more) CAN be removed from the class. The decision is up to the sponsor.
6. Any student on the school attendance sanction list CAN be removed from the SGA class. The decision is up to the sponsor.
7. Any form of bullying, personal or cyber, addressed by administration may result in removal of office.
8. Any student put in internal suspension will result in a one-on-one conference with the sponsor and an administrator. Possible removal from the SGA class may occur the following semester.
